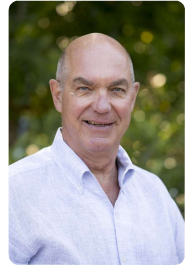


James C. Vogelzang

Over the last thirty years, James C. Vogelzang has spent countless hours speaking, teaching, and listening to men and women in prison and after they come home. He is the founder and president of Doing HIS Time, a nonprofit organization that offers “hands-on grace” to those in prison and upon their release.

Jim’s first book, *Doing HIS Time: Meditations and Prayers for Men and Women in Prison*, has over six hundred thousand (600,000) copies in print in fifty countries and has been translated into seventeen languages.
